

CMRA General Meeting Minutes – 5/13/25

Jim, K0MIZ, called the meeting to order at 7:00 PM at Boone County Electric Coop.

GENERAL BUSINESS

- There were 18 members present.
- Minutes from the April meeting were approved with corrections. Please read the minutes on the website prior to any meeting as they are not read at the meeting.
- Herb, K0ZB, presented the treasurers report and reported that the transfer to Tigers Community Credit Union is completed and most of the funds have been transferred with a checking balance of \$7,519.63. The CD remains at Central Bank with a balance of \$2,357.80. The Treasurers report was approved.

MISCELLANEOUS

- Committee/Officer Reports:
 - **Technical Committee** – Dustin, KF0MLB, has met, via internet, with the committee and discussed topics such as website changes, laptops for VE Testing, and POTA use of the K0SI callsign. Bob, AE0UB, is still working on conversion of VE Testing from paper to online. Also, the committee is researching website options and features the club may want and/or use via internet, plus other technical options the club may be interested in.
 - **Education** – Herb, K0ZB, reported that the fall Technician Class started on October 2nd, with demo night on October 16th and testing on November 6th. Spring class starts on March 5, 2026. We ask all available VE's to attend testing and anyone interested in helping to join us. Also, we ask newly licensed technicians on the first night of class. He also discussed the ARRL Teachers Institute and the Education Committee attempt to get local school teachers in this STEM program. See ARRL.ORG for details.
 - **Membership** – Tim, KE8UAW, a recent Technician Class graduate and newly licensed technician was voted as a new member.
 - **Testing** – Bob, AE0UB, reported that the Technician Class produced 8 new Technicians, and 1 new General. The April Testing produced 4 new Technicians and 2 Generals.

OLD BUSINESS

- In Bill, N0AXZ, absence from the meeting, the club discussed the upcoming Lewis and Clark Trails on the Air (LCTOTA). Contact Bill, N0AXZ, to sign up as an activator, and download the rules/instructions from the LCTOTA.ORG website. Or, operate as a hunter trying to contact all the states involved.
- John, NO0I, previously reported he will be running a POTA station in Texas. Unfortunately, due to illness, he was unable to make the trip.
- Bill, KE0SIY, discussed the upcoming Ready Festival in September. BCARES is taking the lead on this event for Amateur Radio.
- Jim, K0MIZ, discussed the Field Day. The rules have been published. Jim printed them and passed around a notebook for members to review. He mentioned several changes in the rules.

- Bob, AE0UB, passed out a proposed policy regarding the use of the K0SI callsign. Several comments and suggestions were made. This policy has been passed around the board and the Technical Committee previously and they helped refine this. Bob, AE0UB, reported he will incorporate the changes discussed during the meeting, submit the file to Dustin, KF0MLB, to post on the website for all to review, then next month we will readdress this policy and decide whether to approve or not.
