

## FCC License Testing Requirements and Costs - v3

Central Missouri Radio Association (CMRA)

We test for all Amateur Radio License levels: Technician, General, and Amateur Extra.

Testing is on the 3<sup>rd</sup> Tuesday each month.

To take an Amateur Radio License test you must have:

- Photo ID
- \$15.00 testing fee – Prefer Credit Card, but an accept Cash and/or Check
- Federal Registration Number (FRN Number) – Go to <https://apps.fcc.gov> to create an account and apply for a FRN Number.
- If already licensed, and going for a higher license, bring a copy of your license

**NOTE: You MUST have a FRN to register for a testing session, and to attend a session!**

Walk-ins are welcome for testing but preregistration is recommended. To register for an upcoming test:

- Go to <https://HamStudy.org>
- Click on ‘Find a Session’
- Under the tab, ‘Located’, click on ‘Choose’ and enter the zip code of 65203
- Click on any upcoming session you plan to attend
- Click on ‘Register’ and follow the prompts. You will need an FRN Number to register

We have a new testing location:

- 601 Business Loop I-70W, Columbia, MO 65203 (Parkade Plaza)
- Enter the Mall in the North East MACC Mall Entrance (Facing I-70)
- Go down the stairs to your right.
- At bottom of stairs, turn right at first intersection before study room, follow hall to room B34.

If you fail a test, a retest will cost the same \$15.00.

If you pass you can take the next higher level exam for free on the same testing night.

FCC License Testing Costs – Once you pass a test, and the paperwork/test results are submitted through our system to the FCC, the FCC will request you pay a \$35.00 license fee.
