SHIP 73 Committee Report – (Rex W0RXR) This Thursday USGS will be doing a presentation on robot kayak's. August 8<sup>th</sup> is a scheduled sailing event at Mark Twain Lake. Two sailing dingees were also presented as a gift to the SHIP. Further discussion ensued about the scouting project.

Jane (KD0VTM) presented the club with two oscilloscopes to be used for members of the club. Myron (W0ZH) will be looking both scopes over for any maintenance or calibration needed. The test equipment will be kept as part of the club inventory to be checked out by members.

## Old Business

Lewis and Clark Trail On The Air LCTOTA (Corey KF0U) – The final numbers for the event have been tallied. Overall, the club had 2133 contacts for the two weeks. Eight operators participated in using the club callsign to commemorate the Lewis and Clark Trail annual event. 20M netted the most contacts with 40m also representing a large chunk of the total numbers. Of the eight, four operators had over 300 contacts.

Field Day (Jim K0MIZ) – Turned in final report and it has been accepted by the ARRL. There were 25 cw, 72 digital, 90 phone (15 were GOTA) contacts for 568 points. Bonus points

brought the total to 1725. Thanks to Herb (K0ZB) for another outstanding grilling session. Discussion ensued about what went right and where improvement may be needed for next year.
