

CMRA General Meeting Minutes - 7/9/24

Jim, KOMIZ, called the meeting to order at 7:01 PM at Boone County Electric.

GENERAL BUSINESS

- There were 21 members present.
- Minutes from the June meeting were approved. Please read the minutes on the website prior to any meeting as they are not read at the meeting.
- Our Treasurer, Herb, KOZB, reported a checking balance of \$7,327.48 and a CD balance of \$2,341.66; and reported on recent deposits and expenses. He also discussed the recent re-certification of CMRA with the Secretary of State, and why it was needed.

MISCELLANEOUS

- Committee/Officer Reports:
 - **Education** – Herb, KOZB, reported that we have 2 students scheduled for the Fall Technician Class. He reported the Fall 2024 class will start on October 3rd, running for 6 weeks. He reminded the group that demo night will be October 17th, and testing will be on November 7th. He asked all to help with Demo Night, even if you do not bring equipment down; as well come in on testing night as a couple of non VE's would be helpful with paperwork handling.
 - **President Report** – Our president, Jim KOMIZ, reported:
 - That our attempt to reserve space at Shakespeare Pizza for our Christmas Party failed. They had no available space at any of the 3 locations.
 - We currently have the Watt Room and Kitchen at Boone Electric Coop reserved for the December meeting. A discussion continued on reservations for 2025, and Jim reported that reservation are not accepted until the date announcing reservations are open in November. He said on that date you need to sign in at midnight to make reservations as spaces fill up quickly.
 - The September 2024 meeting will not be at Boone Electric as the room was not available for registration, therefore, they have reserved the Club House at Wyndham Ridge, 5720 Abercorn Dr, in south Columbia.
 - A discussion followed with recommendations made for our Christmas Party ranging from a Pot Luck Dinner, to the club providing the main dishes (pot luck the rest), to a full catered event. More discussions to follow.
 - **Secretary** - Bob, AE0UB, provided update to the recently shredding of old testing records. He reported all old records have been properly shredded and disposed of. He reported we had six membership applications pending. Each applicant introduced themselves, then left the room. All applicants were approved for membership. The policy requires a committee to manage said equipment and is asking the members to review the policy, make any recommendations for improvement, and asked members to consider being a part of that committee. We currently have one radio but no power supply or antenna.
- John, N00I, is looking into the possibility of performing Ham demonstrations in various schools in support of their STEM classes. He is looking more into that.
- Bob, AE0UB, suggest that the club plan a POTA outing, possibly in the fall.
- Earnest, KC0EZE, discussed past Cub Scout Ham events, and introduced BCARES for the new members. He also briefly discussed the upcoming SET planned for November this year.
- Herb, K0ZB, reminded that dues are due.
