 - Current operating plans are; a GOTA (Get on the Air) station, a SSB station, a digital station (e.g FT8). Others are planning to bring their own equipment, for e.g., WD6BGN plans to setup a 6 meter station.

- Christmas party update (KF0GUS and K0MIZ)
 - o Grand Gru restaurant is available per KF0GUS. This would be a per person cost and the estimate would be in the \$25 range, which might be subject to change by December as food prices continue to uptick.
 - o K0MIZ contacted Shakespeare's Pizza Columbia on Grindstone. They have a party room (Denver) available. They would charge \$100 and no other charges.

New Business

- Ashland UHF repeater (444.175) opportunity. Technical committee (N0AXZ, KC0EZE and AD0ZE) have been investigating possible acquisition.
 - o Open discussion by all.
 - The current equipment owners are ready to move on (sell) from equipment ownership asap. Members of CMRA and BCARES groups are very interested in acquiring this configuration. The repeater equipment is estimated at \$1500 which would be transferred to the current owners upon sale agreement. An insurance cost would be part of the transaction as well and is needed.
 - The Ashland UHF repeater is 499 ft. high located west of Ashland. Has excellent coverage in the county, callsign KD0SAF.
 - The equipment inventory includes the MOTO repeater, coax, duplexer (currently on the air) and a Yaesu Fusion/Analog repeater (not on the air).
 - Site includes internet access port via iZone provider.
 - Steve Semon from Sedalia and his wife were our guest. Steve is the owner of the tower and associated tower accessories via his commercial business. His requirement is the next owner(s) maintain the grounds in proper maintenance (such cut crass regularly, for e.g). We appreciated his exchange of information to the club about the repeater operation.
 - o Big John AD0ZE and Chris K0PHP volunteered to cut the grass.
 - There was a lot of interest expressed by members of both CMRA and BCARES pursuing the acquisition of this repeater configuration. An opportunity like this is rare
 - Some members are leaning toward the repeater as a part of BCARES since it would be highly useful in their mission. KC0EZE, K0PHP, N0AXZ and AD0ZE are looking into this opportunity for BCARES as an asset.
 - o W0TES, Tim is looking into insurance options for the club.
 - Look for additional news and information regarding the Ashland repeater to be distributed to CMRA and BCARES members by both club officers in the coming days on the mail server list – groups.io. Also, contact KC0EZE, N0AXZ and AD0ZE directly with questions and concerns.
